Families must submit one application per scholarship. Please be sure all of your students are included on the appropriate scholarship application before submitting.

### Step Up For Students



**FES-UA:** Students from age 3 through grade 12 or age 22, whichever comes first, who have a specific diagnosis or have an IEP.

**<u>FTCFES-EO</u>**: You can use the scholarship to attend an eligible private school, and any remaining funds can be accessed through your education savings account to further support your child's educational needs.

**<u>FTCPEP</u>**: For Florida students who are not enrolled full-time in a private or public school.

<u>New Worlds</u>: The program benefits VPK and K-5 public school students who struggle early in reading and/or math skills.

<u>Transportation Stipend</u>: Supports the transportation costs associated with traveling to a different public school than the one the student has been assigned.

## The FES-UA Renewal Application deadline is April 30th!

If you **accept** a scholarship, you will receive either confirmation of the award OR notice that the scholarship program has reached capacity. This notification will be sent by email.



If you **decline** the scholarship, your student will be withdrawn from the scholarship program. If interested, you will then be able to apply through another scholarship program for this student. Reapplying for the same scholarship or another scholarship will reset your current priority status, and you will be considered a 'New' applicant.

### **New & Renewal Student Application Checklist**

Renewing your child's scholarship for a Private School (FTC/FES-EO), Unique Abilities (FES-UA), or PEP Scholarship requires certain documents for review and this guide is here to help you gather everything you need. If your student received funds in 2024-25, they're considered a renewal student.

### Identifying next steps...

After a student is awarded, the enrollment cycle begins. Schools and scholarship families must work together to ensure that the following steps are taken:

- 1. Schools must set up their 2025 2026 profile in EMA.
- 2. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) must locate the student's award ID and submit it to their eligible school of choice.
- **3.** Schools will use the award ID to enroll students in EMA.
- 4. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) will be prompted in EMA to accept the enrollment request and approve scholarship payments. Schools must confirm student admission and parents must approve each payment to schools before scholarship funds may be transferred from the student's account by the SFO.

### **<u>Student Details – Enrollments</u>**

Once the private school has enrolled your student in EMA, you will receive a notification to log in to your account and review the request. You will be able to see your student's start date, annual tuition amount, any discounts applied, and the total amount due to the school.

Should you wish to change your decision and Confirm Enrollment, choose 'Cancel' to go back to the previous screen.

If you decline enrollment due to an incorrect amount or another concern, the school will have to redo the process and send a new enrollment request. At this point you will need to review and confirm enrollment again.

### Are you sure you want to decline enrollment?

By declining enrollment, your student will not be enrolled in the requested private school in the EMA platform.

FTC/FES-EO private school scholarship students who are not enrolled in a private school in EMA will not be eligible for any scholarship funding; therefore, scholarship funds will not be reserved for payment to the private school. For FES-UA scholarship students, scholarship funds will not be reserved for or paid directly to the private school.

If you decline enrollment, the school may hold you responsible for any payment due for your student's education. For FES-EO/FTC private school scholarship students, your student's scholarship status may be impacted by a failure to enroll in a private school in the EMA platform.

At this time we do not have the staffing for live Q&A sessions during the webinars but all questions turned in after the webinar are reviewed and we do our best to answer them in the following month's webinar.









### Question: My student is in public school and was awarded the UA scholarship after the school year started. Can we finish the year in public school and use our funds?

Answer: Scholarship recipients cannot attend public school. Upon award you would have to immediately and officially withdraw your student from the public school to either attend a private school or homeschool. Neglecting to do this could cause your scholarship to be revoked. You may not attend public school and use the scholarship to pay for therapy. If you are awarded a scholarship for next year, you can finish this year in public school and officially withdraw at the end of the school year. This information can be located in the parent handbook on page 11.

### Question: What should I do if my child is moving to a public school next year for 2025-26 and no longer needs the scholarship?

Answer: If you are going back to public school, please do not renew your FES-UA scholarship for 2025-2026. No further action is needed on your part.





### Question: How are leftover scholarship funds handled at the end of the school year?

Answer: A student's unspent scholarship funds may be rolled over from one school year to the next. However, under Florida law, Step Up For Students cannot transfer funds into the student's scholarship account that would raise the balance above \$50,000. This information can be located in the parent handbook on page 16.

Question: Do I have to upload my whole diagnosis or IEP paperwork for my initial FES-UA application?

Answer: Yes, you will need to upload every page of your diagnosis or IEP paperwork to qualify.

Question: How can I directly pay a provider from my scholarship account if they are not in the provider database in EMA?

Answer: We are always looking for MORE providers! Please have them go to <u>www.stepupforstudents.org</u> to create a Provider account to get started!



Question: How do I have my child's private school receive funds directly every quarter?

Answer: You can give your Award ID to the school enroll your student in their EMA portal to have invoices generate quarterly that you will approve in EMA. The school will receive payment seven business days after your approval.

Question: For the Legacy families who are now submitting reimbursements and pre-authorizations in EMA with all other scholarship users, how do we do that?

Question: Does everyone need to upload diagnosis documentation every year when they apply or renew?

Answer: First time application: everyone submits diagnosis documentation. After that, only students awarded under Hospital or Homebound or High Risk need future diagnosis documents uploaded.
