Wrapping Up 23-24 SY Payments

- We are still making payments from Q4 invoicing, as well as any outstanding invoices from prior quarters.
- There will be some additional funding and invoices over the next several weeks for students with issues that are outstanding.
- We are still resolving some technical issues regarding Receivables noted in EMA.
 We are in the process of validating those receivables. Once validated, SUFS will send you an invoice for that overpayment prior to Q1 and hopefully before June 30th. Please return those funds as soon as possible. Funds not sent back will be collected from Q1 2024-25 payments.
- SUFS has currently paid 99.4% of all invoices approved by schools this year.

2024-25 Funding Updates

Beginning with the 2024-25 school year, SFOs will initiate quarterly payments for full-time, in-person students at an eligible private school within 7 business days of the parent and school approval.

The 2024-25 Funding Calendar will arrive later this summer. Watch your office email and attend the June Office Hours!


To be presented for the August 1 funding file, students must be enrolled (including the parent confirmation) by June 30th.

Hope Enrollment

- The Hope Scholarship Program will be merged with the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC) scholarship programs.
- All eligible financial contributions will be directed to the FTC scholarship program.
- The legislative changes will allow students with bullying incidents documented by their public schools to continue to qualify for FTC scholarships after application close.
- Current Hope Scholarship recipients will apply as FTC or FES-EO Scholarship recipients. All students will be enrolled in EMA!

Hope Scholarship: Legislative Updates

School Actions for 2024 – 25 SY

- Schools will take 2024-25 actions in EMA this month, including setting up their tuition & fees and enrolling students.
- You can begin collecting Award IDs now, as you will need these again for enrollment.
 - New Feature Alert: Parents will also have the option to print their ID in the coming weeks.
- With the new DOE funding timelines, it's important to submit T&F in a timely manner and complete enrollments once approved.

Tuition & Fees Reminders



Schools, finalize your Tuition and Fees (T&F) amounts NOW, do not wait for scholarship amounts to be released. Once you submit maximum schedules and enroll students, those schedules will be locked. You CAN add additional schedules at a lower amount, but you can't change their maximums.

Once you submit your Tuition and Fees (T&F), it may take up to 10 business days to verify them before you can start enrolling students.

Your school must be 2024-25 compliant with the Department of Education (DOE) before they can start enrolling students.

FES-UA students are eligible for preschool enrollment (3-5yo).

Age 3 Students: FES-UA Legislative Updates

Pre-K updates coming soon! When completing your tuition and fees, you'll be asked to enter your Pre-K tuition and fees if your private school is reported in its Annual Survey with the Florida Department of Education that your school serves Pre-K students. Keep an eye out for an email with even more updates about Pre-K students benefiting from the FES-UA program.

Once the enrollment process begins, we encourage schools to enroll students in EMA as quickly as possible. Please be sure to enter your maximum tuition and fee rate for PreK as you submit your tuition and fee rates. However, please note that PreK enrollment for FES-UA students will begin later this summer. This will ensure that as many students as possible are able to be fully enrolled in time for the first funding distribution of the fall.




Personalized Education Program (PEP)

 PEP students can now spend at least two school days per week at a private school's physical location having direct contact with teachers. If PEP students choose to educate using this model, they will need to address remaining instructional time, occurring outside of the private school, in their student learning plan.

The FLDOE will be instituting a new compliant process for private schools desiring to serve PEP families in the 24-25 school year. Any schools that are interested in serving the PEP population in this way need to email schoolchoice@fldoe.org. In the email, please include the school's name, school code (if applicable) and explain that the school wishes to serve PEP students under the new hybrid learning language.


PEP & Assessments



In compliance with statute, all PEP Renewal families are required to provide a standardized assessment result. Please refer to https://www.fldoe.org/schools/school-choice/k-12-scholarship-programs/ftc/annual-assessment-requirement.stml for further details.

Information on the submission process will be coming in the spring. Please be aware that scores are required for funding and they must be submitted by July 31st.

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


