Elective Courses



Definition

An Elective or Enrichment program offers non-core courses, classes, or activities to scholarship students. A credentialed individual provider must meet at least one of the requirements below to be eligible for this service category.

Eligible programs: FES-UA, FTC, FES-EO, PEP

Account Type(s): Business, Personal

Credentials for an Elective Provider:

- Eligible to provide part-time tutoring services as identified by the requirements listed here.
- Valid or expired Florida educator's certificate
- Minimum of three years of experience in the relevant subject area as demonstrated by employment records (full Resume or LinkedIn Profile may be submitted to validate) *
- Current enrollment in a postsecondary educational institution as a student of the relevant subject area*
- Degree from a postsecondary educational institution in the relevant subject area*
 - * Degrees and enrollment documentation should include transcripts demonstrating the subject area of expertise
- Certification or national accreditation in the relevant subject area

Required Service Catalog Documentation:

- First and last name of the individual rendering services
- Proof of mastery/documentation of certification (see list, above)
- Subject area(s) in which instruction will be provided
