Definitions & prerequisites

The term "specialized" means a program developed specifically for students with special or unique needs or a program that can meet the student's needs.

- Overnight educational camps may be permitted with Pre-Authorization and documentation of the educational benefit from a physician or licensed therapist.
- Published fees must be provided to the SFO prior to receipt of any FES-UA funding.
 Proof of attendance is required.
- For students aged 16 and up, full or half day education programs are permitted with Pre-Authorization. (*After-School Education Programs only*)

Note: After-school or extended care, if the program has no educational component, it will not be approved.

Required Service Catalog documentation

• Description of service(s) that will be rendered.

Eligible programs: FES-UA and New Worlds Scholarship Accounts (New Worlds can only be approved if the service or program is reading-, literacy-, or math-related.)

Vendor receipt/invoice must include:

- Scholarship student's first and last name (as it appears on the scholarship).
- Date of the program, including year
- Description of services provided
- Amount of fees
- Proof of payment documentation (if the payee is the parent-guardian)
