Specialized Services

Definition

Specialized Services are rendered by the approved providers listed below or a Florida hospital. Services may be delivered outside Florida if credentialed. Online delivery is eligible.

Required Service Catalog documentation

- First and last name of the person rendering services.
- A copy of their FLDOH license number.

Eligible program: FES-UA

An approved provider is:

- Licensed by the <u>Florida Department of Health</u> to perform the service
- Approved as a provider by the <u>Agency for Persons with Disabilities</u>,
- Approved as a <u>Specialized Instructional Services (SIS) Provider by the Office of Early Learning</u>.
 Note: An approved provider must provide services in the specialized area in which they are approved.

Approved services include:

- Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA)
- Speech-Language services by a Florida Department of Health licensed speech-language pathologist (SLP)
- Occupational therapy services by a Florida Department of Health licensed occupational therapist
- Physical therapy services by Florida Department of Health licensed physical therapist
- Spoken language services by a Florida Department of Health licensed listening and spoken language specialist
- Psychotherapy or counseling by a Florida Department of Health licensed psychologist, school psychologist, mental health counselor, marriage and family therapist, or clinical social worker
- Vision therapy by a Florida Department of Health licensed Optometrist

Ineligible under Specialized Services

- A service that is not rendered by a provider in the specialized area
 - \circ $\;$ Example: Occupational therapy services rendered by a psychologist $\;$
- Any other therapy or specialized service other than the services outlined above
 - Example: Massage therapy, acupuncture, chiropractic therapy, etc.
- An educational program, home education program, or tutoring

- These programs and services have different requirements and credentials to be considered eligible. The eligibility requirements are listed below.
- Service catalogs submitted by therapy assistants, interns, or technicians
 - These services must be submitted under a fully credentialed, supervising therapist in order to be approved

Vendor receipt/invoice must include:

- Scholarship student's first and last name (as it appears on the scholarship).
- Date of purchase/dates of service
- Vendor/provider name
- Description of item/service
- Receipt breakdown: item price, subtotal, taxes, fees, discounts, and grand total
- Proof of payment documentation
 Note: Receipt/invoice should be on your business letterhead
