

Specialized After School Education Program



Definition

Students with NWSA funds and recipients of the FES-UA scholarship are eligible to use their funds for after school education programs.

- For NWSA students, the programs must be designed to improve reading and literacy or math skills.
- For FES-UA students, the programs must be specialized. The term “specialized” means a program developed specifically for students with special or unique needs or a program that can meet the student’s needs.

Eligible Programs: NWSA & FES-UA
