The Educational Benefit Form (EBF) helps you better define the educational benefit of a purchase and MUST be submitted for reimbursement requests in the <u>Elective or Field Trips</u> <u>categories.</u>

Educational Benefit Form: What's its purpose?

 The EBF was added for the Electives and Field Trip categories as these two categories have substantially grown based on parent/guardian feedback. This form allows us to collect more detailed information about the educational benefit of some of the more innovative uses of the ESAs.

 Parents/guardians are welcome to use it for reimbursements in other categories as well, but it will help our teams make more informed decisions, ultimately allowing faster responses as well as fewer reimbursements being placed on hold.

Educational Benefit Form

- This form must be used by <u>new families in EMA</u>.
- Elective and Field Trip reimbursements that do not include the EBF will be put on hold until the form is submitted.
- If a reimbursement is miscategorized and should have been in the electives or field trip category, then the reimbursement will be re-categorized and put on hold if the EBF was not submitted.
- If a parent/guardian seeks reimbursement for something like Legos or blocks or other items that already
 have their own defined category to go under curriculum, then the parent/guardian needs to give the
 curriculum demonstrating that it's required. The definition of curriculum includes required supplemental
 materials, so please demonstrate this at the time of submission.

After clicking on the "Reserve Funds" button, you will be redirected to a screen where you will be required to grant permission to the service provider to access your contact information. You will have to check the "Yes" box and click "Confirm" to reserve funds for the service you are requesting from the provider.



When funds are reserved, the provider can submit payment for services without further parent approval.

Important information about Find a Provider:

• <u>Payments to Providers are now parent/guardian initiated</u>. This means parents/guardians must first reserve available funds for payment to an approved provider. The provider can only submit an invoice for services after the funds have been reserved for the provider by the parent/guardian. The provider also can delete reserved funds and send them back to the ESA.

- MyScholarShop returns are done through the vendors. Return information is available on the MSS Vendor Page. SUFS cannot process a return of a purchase from MSS.
- Please follow the vendor return info in MSS and do NOT to attempt to return the items to a physical store.

ANNUAL ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENT

Florida Statutes require a private school participating in either prong of the Family Empowerment Scholarship Program, the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program or the Hope Scholarship Program to demonstrate academic accountability by annually administering or making provisions for students participating in a scholarship program to take one of the nationally normreferenced tests identified by the Department of Education or the statewide assessments pursuant to Section 1008.22, Florida Statutes.

It's Q & A Time!

If you want to withdraw from PEP mid-year, do you just file a county notice of intent, or would spend \$ need 2 be returned? Spent money is not returned. No further funding would be received for the remaining quarters.

I submitted several reimbursement requests several weeks ago and haven't heard anything. What is the timeframe to receive a response? Please continue to monitor your email and your EMA account for updates.

Can I be a part-time tutor as well as a Guardian? You can be a guardian and a part-time tutor but are not allowed to be paid to tutor your child.

Can you use the scholarship debit card in Amazon for educational equipment? Yes, once a reimbursement is approved and funds are available, you can spend those funds in any way you see fit.

My private school is having trouble enrolling us as PEP students part-time. Is there a clear process for this? We are working with the Department of Education to ensure this process is clearly communicated to our schools.

Can funds all be spent in a single quarter but reimbursed throughout the year? Funds are deposited quarterly, you will be able to spend the full amount each quarter. Ex: If you would like to spend more during the first two quarters and then submit for reimbursement during the second two quarters, you can do that.

I need advice on homeschooling to provide the best experience for my son's first year as a homeschool student. MSS offers SUFS-vetted options and they are approved. We also encourage utilizing your scholarship funds for a Choice Navigator to help support you.

Can I buy a more affordable baby doll and high-chair from Walmart or cheaper storage from Ikea and get reimbursed? Or do I need to purchase the items that are available on MyScholarShop? Also, how long does it take to receive reimbursement after making a request? Direct purchases require approval for reimbursements.

Can I teach my daughter a cooking class and be reimbursed for it because I have a teaching certificate with Florida? No, you cannot pay yourself for teaching your child.

It's Q & A Time!

Why are we not allowed digital devices? Public and private school kids have access to tablets, laptops, and desktops in school and at home from the school. TV's are allowed. Many of us would prefer digital devices like laptops and tablets over TVs.

Per statute, FTC/EO/PEP authorized uses of funds include "digital materials". The FES-UA allows for "digital devices" (see below). With guidance from the DOE, and legislature, this clear distinction, between "digital materials" and "digital devices" is why PEP students are unable to purchase items such as computers, laptops, etc.

1002.394

(4) AUTHORIZED USES OF PROGRAM FUNDS.—

(a) Program funds awarded to a student determined eligible pursuant to paragraph (3)(a) may be used for:

1. Tuition and fees at an eligible private school.; or

2. Transportation to a Florida public school in which a student is enrolled and that is different from the school to which the student was assigned or to a lab school as defined in s. 1002.32

3. Instructional materials, including digital materials and Internet resources...

(b) Program funds awarded to a student with a disability determined eligible pursuant to paragraph (3)(b) may be used for the following purposes: 1. Instructional materials, including *digital devices*, digital periphery devices, and assistive technology devices that allow a student to access instruction or instructional content and training on the use of and maintenance agreements for these devices.

Step Up is aware of this need, but unfortunately, the statute limits us from approving those items for PEP families. We always encourage parent advocacy.
