Florida 529 Savings Plan Scholarship Contribution Guide



What is the Florida 529 Savings Plan?

The Florida 529 Savings Plan is a flexible, affordable and tax-free way to save for college. Unique Abilities Scholarship funds may be deposited into a Florida 529 account for postsecondary education expenses only. These funds cannot be used for K–12 private school costs.

How to Contribute Scholarship Funds

- 1. Sign into your EMA account and select Marketplace.
- 2. Use the Find Providers feature.
- 3. Select the student you're contributing for.
- 4. Choose the provider and location.
- 5. Enter the contribution amount (cannot be changed later).
- 6. In the Notes section, enter the 10-digit Florida 529 Savings Plan account number.
- 7. Double-check all information and click RESERVE FUNDS.
- 8. Grant permission to share your contact info with the provider by checking "Yes" and clicking CONFIRM.

Finding the 10-Digit Account Number

- Log into the Florida Prepaid portal.
- Locate the number on:
 - o Your dashboard, or
 - o Your account statement

Please note: Step Up For Students cannot provide this number. Contact your 529 account holder if needed.

Direct Payment Requests

To request a direct payment from your scholarship account:

- Submit a Florida 529 Savings Plan statement showing:
 - o Student's full name
 - o 10-digit 529 account number
 - o Account type (must be UTMA or UGMA)
 - o Student's name on the scholarship account must match the name of the Florida 529 College Savings Plan beneficiary

Please note: An incorrect account number may cause processing failures.

Important Notes

- The process for contributing to the Florida Prepaid College Fund is different.
- Be sure to follow the correct steps for the plan you are using.

Reminder!

The process for contributing to a Florida 529 Savings Plan is not the same as the process for contributing to the Florida Prepaid College Fund. Follow the correct steps depending on which plan you use.
