



## Hurricane Relief Proof of Residency

In partnership with the Florida Department of Education, Step Up For Students has created an alternative Proof of Residency documentation for families recently displaced by a hurricane. Families who are temporarily relocating to a new address **within the state of Florida** and applying for a scholarship for the first time for the 2024-25 school year should provide their former residential address, prior to Hurricane Helene, as the Physical Address in EMA. If a temporary address within the state of Florida is known at this time, list it as the mailing address, to allow purchases to be shipped to the temporary residence. Please utilize this form in lieu of Proof of Residency for either address.

**Note:** Families who have temporarily or permanently relocated out of the state of Florida are not eligible for a scholarship and should not submit a scholarship application unless/until they have returned to residing in the state of Florida. Scholarship application or participation while residing outside of the state of Florida is only permitted for students of Active-Duty Members of the Armed Forces who are assigned out of state on Permanent Change of Station orders.

I affirm that I have read and understood the above information and affirm that I am temporarily displaced by Hurricane Helene or Milton and residing away from my permanent residence but within the state of Florida. I understand that I am subject to all other terms and conditions of the scholarship, and that any misrepresentation of address or residency may be considered fraud and could incur loss of scholarship, return of scholarship funds, or financial or legal penalties.
