

## A LEARNING OPTION FOR STRUGGLING STUDENTS

Florida became the first state to offer an education savings account (ESA) program for students enrolled in public schools. The program offers parents of VPK students or public school students in grades in K-5, access to education savings accounts, worth \$1,200, to pay for tuition and fees related to part-time tutoring, summer and after-school literacy or math programs, instructional materials and curriculum related to reading or literacy or mathematics

## STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

- Students must in VPK or grades K-5.
- Must have scored below a level 3 in the most recent statewide assessment in English Language Arts or Mathematics.
- A VPK student enrolled in a public or private school exhibiting substantial deficiencies in early literacy based on the most recent monitoring results.
- Exhibit characteristics of dyslexia or dyscalculia
- Students classified as English Language Learners receive priority.
- Must remain enrolled in a public school or in VPK.
